1508. Village maintenance

Proposed: that the PC passes responsibility for the maintenance of the Village Hall (VH) grounds to the VH Management Committee, and offers an annual contribution of £400. In addition, the Clerk will investigate alternative options for maintaining the play equipment (at both the VH and Stewarts Green) and for general village maintenance, with a view to the PC making a decision on future arrangements at the March 2022 PC meeting before the start of the new financial year.'

1510. Reports & Issues (for information only):

- AQUIND - The Secretary of State for Business Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) announced 20/01/22 that he has refused the Aquind Interconnector application.
- 'Pipe' near OFTR - villager has reported a section of metal pipe sticking out of the ground on the verge just past the pinch point on the B2150 by the OFTR. Clerk suspected that could be related to the nearby telegraph pole & reported to BT who sent out an engineer that day. No update yet received from BT but traffic cone has been placed over the pipe. Clerk to chase.
- Rattling manhole covers - Cllr Silcock has reported noisy manhole covers on West St. Clerk to investigate who is responsible for them and request mitigation work.
- HCC Parish and Town Council Event (Economy, Transport & Environment) - 17/03/22 - updates on latest economic recovery position, and Hampshire Highways and related service issues.
