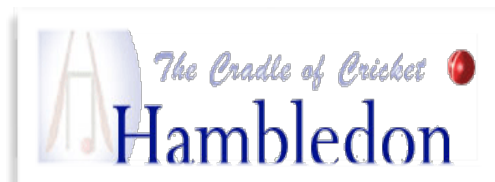

News from Winchester CC

Cllr Vicki Weston's report for Jan 2020 can be found on the PC website ('Council Meetings' page; associated documents to Jan 2020). Topics covered are as follows:

- Carbon Neutrality Action Plan** - WCC to review its activities to achieve carbon neutrality by 2024; with the same goal for the wider district by 2030.
- Fly-tipping** - has increased in the run-up to Christmas. WCC responsible for removing from public land and highways, but the land-owner is responsible for removal of fly-tipping on private property. Reporting should be done on-line or via tel. 0300 300 0013.
