- Cllr Lumby has very kindly approved a County Councillor grant of £500 towards the Stewarts Green Playground fund.
- HMRC have conceded that charges for local authority sports facilities are a non-business activity and outside the scope of VAT. [For Hambledon, this means that there is no need to become VAT registered due to the additional income from tennis activities.]
- The Government have increased the £25,000 threshold for Contracts Finder to £30,000 from 21st December 2022. This puts us back to the position where it is effectively contracts over £25,000 plus VAT (rather than £25,000 including VAT) are advertised.
