1689	Public questions & comments	<p>Standing orders suspended for maximum 10 mins.</p> <p>Members of the public commented on planning application SDNP/22/02655/FUL as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On behalf of VH Committee - circa £12k grant has been received as contribution towards installation. Support from environmental & climate change groups. Ref to HVDG 33 (VDS). Solar panels are already in situ in Old Barn Crescent & these are visible from the road. Consistent with SDNP Climate Change plan. Main issue is increase in energy costs. Running costs are due to increase massively. Recreation & entertainment - main reason for VH - if Committee can't afford to heat etc it will no longer be viable. • Hambledon Greening member - support - VH is a key village amenity. • MoP commented that they were supportive but held concerns about the visual impact of the cells - what are they made from? Important for them not to be shiny, esp for villagers living opposite the VH. • Another MoP supported the view that shiny cells should not be used and noted that the view from Speltham Down could also be impacted. • Villager living opposite the VH very supportive but commented that the 'prettier' the better. <p>Cllr Encke disclosed a non-pecuniary interest as part of the VH Committee and as such Cllrs agreed that she could remain in the meeting room but not take part in any discussion or vote on SDNP/22/02655/FUL.</p>

1691	Planning applications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SDNP/22/02655/FUL - Hambledon Village Hall, West Street, Hambledon, Hampshire PO7 4RW. To install Solar Voltaic Panels to the Village Hall south facing roof. <u>SUPPORT - but the PC asks for the application to be called in to the SDNP Planning Committee. If minded to approve, the PC requests that a sensitive design is developed before final approval is given.</u> (Cllrs voted 3 for; 1 against.) • SDNP/22/02709/HOUS - Downings, West Street, Hambledon, Hampshire, PO7 4SN. Single storey rear extension. <u>NO OBJECTION.</u> • SDNP/22/02588/HOUS Rushmere Stud, Speltham Hill, Hambledon, Hampshire, PO7 4SE. Removal of existing single storey structure and replacement with new two storey chalet style extension, with revised fenestration and revised materials to external walls to existing dwelling to create a homogenous dwelling. <u>NO OBJECTION - however, the increase in internal gross volume appears to be 67%, which is 37% more than the permitted max in the SDNP of 30%. Planning Officer advised to check.</u> • SDNP/22/03365/TCA - Harwood House, Hambledon Road, Hambledon, Hampshire, PO7 4QN. Two Ash trees (T1 and T2) adjacent to Field Maple suffering from Ash dieback to be removed. One Ash tree (T3) adjacent to southwest corner of garden suffering from Ash dieback to be removed. One Horse Chestnut (T4) located on edge of large Laurel Bush to be removed to facilitate growth of adjacent larger healthy Ash tree. One Norway Spruce (T5) adjacent to Field Maple leaning heavily to be removed. One Ash (T6) at entrance, dead and fallen but currently supported by adjacent tree branches to be removed before it falls down on driveway. <u>NO COMMENT.</u>
