### Website:

### Repair Café:

- The opening of this has been postponed until April due to Covid concerns but we have had at least 4 people sign up to be 'fixers' and an enthusiastic response in general to the idea.

### Recycling:

- Hambleton School, Pre-School and After School Club are now collecting milk bottle tops and crisp packets. Hambleton WI has agreed to make sustainable bags with ID, to put in each building.
- An article about local recycling facilities has been written up for the next Hambletonian issue including notes about how villagers can get their recyclables collected if they can't access these facilities themselves. We have also asked for volunteers to help sort the recycled materials at Denmead as part of their rota.

### Renaturing/Wilder Community:

- John and Christine Dunkley have agreed to lead a Hambleton Wilder Community with support from HIWWT Team Wilder. We met with them last week to begin planning and they will now work with Craig Whitelock of HIWWT to determine what projects they would like to initiate.
