- Murder Stone - no grant for restoration available from HCC; further damage to the remaining stone has occurred (could be due to weather conditions?). PC has taken advice from the Police - in the absence of an eyewitness it is unlikely that the Police would conduct an investigation. WCC Conservation Officer

visiting the remaining stone w/c 31/08 and will advise further since Heritage Britain have to be informed of damage to Grade 2 listed monuments.

- Water leak at School-end of footpath 15a - Portsmouth Water investigating; potential source identified & meeting with customer was booked for 19/08/20 but cancelled last minute. To be re-booked. Awaiting update.
- AQUIND - Cllr Quinn to update council.
- Manhole Covers (West St & East St) - correspondence received from villager re. noise issues related to vehicles driving over uneven manholes/manhole covers. Correction work started 01/09/20.
- Village Fireworks Evening 2020 - cancelled due to Covid-19 public gathering restrictions.
- Great British September Clean 11-27 Sept 2020 - notice received in insufficient time to plan a village response.
