As part of the programme of works being undertaken by Operation Resilience we will be undertaking Carriageway Resurfacing in Menslands Lane, Hambledon. The works are programmed to start on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2017 and are expected to last for 1 day. In order to undertake the works safely it will be necessary to close the road between approximately 08:00-17:00hrs.
