2906. Planning Applications

- SDNP/25/04920/FUL - Corhampton Golf Club Shepherds Farm Lane Corhampton Hampshire SO32 3GZ. Change of use from agricultural field to golf course including creation of 4 holes, associated fairways and tees, with an irrigation pond in the south west corner of the field and works associated with the existing golf course including; reshaping of existing fairways and tees, translocating trees, with new chalk grassland and chalk scrapes over the whole site.
- SDNP/26/00103/HOUS - Cams Hill Wood, Cams Hill Lane, Hambledon, Hampshire, PO7 4SP. Proposed single storey side extension, alterations to existing conservatory to create new snug, and insertion of roof lights to main pitch roof.

- SDNP/25/05051/TCA - T1 Ash - Oldfield House, Speltham Hill, Hambledon, Hampshire, PO7 4SE. Reduce ash tree back to old pollard / pruning points. Reason for works: tree has grown up to 4m from last time it was pruned, general maintenance of the tree due to location.

- MHCLG has confirmed that appropriate sum for the purposes of section 137(4)(a) of the Local Government Act 1972 for parish and town councils in England for the financial year 2026/27 will be £11.60 per elector.
- Collapsed curb-stone outside of the Peoples Market has been reported to HCC (enquiry ref 21849987). Latest update (15/01/26) - 'works to be scheduled'.
- Water leakage from pothole repairs, Speltham Hill, 15/01/26 - reported to HCC; passed to Portsmouth Water (which confirmed that it was not a burst mains pipe & appeared to be ground water); passed to CityFibre (?).
- WCC Proposed Main Modifications to the Local Plan consultation - Cllr Encke reviewed this on behalf of the PC and concluded that no response was required.
- Central Government consultation on LGR response submitted (copy of the response will be provided in the appendix to the minutes).
