M27 closure June 14th-15th - Highways England are continuing to carry out the smart motorways programme on the M27. As part of this the North Fareham footbridge will be demolished and replaced between 9pm on 14 June and 9pm on 15 June.

During this time there will be a full closure of the M27 between junctions 9 and 11. The diversion route will be on the A27 and the A32.
