

Hambledon Hilly 10km

The Hambledon Hilly 10km is taking place on Saturday 21 September starting at the Village Hall. The route will take the runners out of Hambledon via East Street and Glidden Lane at 11.30 am, onto Dogkennel Lane, Horsepost Lane, Sawyers Hill, May's Well Lane and then towards Hambledon with Pitt Hill Lane. The runners will then follow the "Donkeytrack" across to Glidden Lane, which will bring them down towards the village, crossing East Street, up to the Vineyard, past the school to enter the village via the High Street to finish at the Village Hall.

The runners will be on the following lanes at these approximate times:

Dogkennel Lane	11.30-11.35
Horsepost Lane	11.35-11.55
Sawyer's Hill	11.45-12.05
Pit Hill Lane, Kidmore Lane cross	11.50-12.10
Pit Hill, Harrowgate Lane cross	11.55-12.15
Vineyard and High Str	12.00-12.45
Village Hall finish	12.05-13.00

A water point and First Aid post will be at the Pit Hill Lane, Harrowgate cross.

All route markers and water bottles will be removed by Saturday evening, however this may run over into Sunday because of the weather, man power, ect.

The Mini Hilly fun run for the children will take place at 10.15 on the Speltham Hill National Trust land. Please come and support the runners on Saturday and join them for food and drinks on the Village green afterwards. All proceeds go to the Hambledon Primary School.

The event will unfortunately create more traffic on the 21nd and we apologise for any inconvenience.
