(FURTHER AMENDMENTS RECEIVED October 2023)- Revised Plans and Reports; Additional Information including Removal of battery storage facility; Reduction to area of solar panels; Revised ES Non-Technical Summary; Additional Landscaping; Creation of Permissive Footpath; Addition of Passing Bays in Day Lane. (May Affect Public Rights of Way & May Affect Setting of Listed Buildings) (Revised Description & Revised Details).</p> <p>[Despite the need for green energy projects, Hambledon PC OBJECTS to the application and supports strongly the reasoning of SDNPA Planning Dept, the WCC Landscape Officer, and Denmead Parish Council. Hambledon PC is particularly concerned about the risks, however small, to the local ground water, as expressed by Portsmouth Water. The cumulative effect of the application if the Aquind project is approved would be to turn a tranquil part of Hampshire into an industrialised one. The affect on the National Park, its approach, and roads leading into our Parish must be considered and the application REFUSED.]</p>
