At the PC meeting on Monday, the Hambledon Greening Working Group requested that the following statement be sent to HCC/WCC for consideration:

'Please could the Cllrs inform us of any plans to upgrade the recycling collections in Hambledon within the next 2 years. At the recent Hambledon Greening Fair, the action that dominated the community's interest and one for which there were many requests to bring about, was to enable much more household waste to be recycled and collected within the parish. The village wishes to activate this and therefore would like to know both councils' plans. Also, HGC have shown interest in two grants which appear on the surface to be available to such projects, only to be told they are for 'waste at source'. Are there plans to open the funding to such projects?'
