Dear Councillor Huxstep

As part of the programme of works being undertaken by Operation Resilience we will be undertaking drainage investigations in Brook Lane, Hambledon. The works are programmed to start on Monday 23rd October 2017 and are expected to last for 1 day. In order to undertake the works safely it will be necessary to close the road from Hambledon Road junction to East Street junction between approximately 08:00-17:00hrs.

Information signs advising road users of the works will be erected approximately 2 weeks before the start of works. A letter will be sent to local residents and an email will be sent to Winchester City Council and Hambledon Parish Council to advise them accordingly.
